ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Rural GCE project was set up as a consortium of six partners from across Europe to address barriers and difficulties in teaching Global Citizenship Education to Rural communities. The partners aim to collaborate to set up over the life of the two-year project an online learning motivational environment with resources that teachers can use to improve the teaching of global citizenship education in their rural communities.



PROJECT PROGRESS



A1 Justification point: Needs analysis and verification- The survey was conducted in the partner countries, validating the needs of the target groups and defining the educational categories to be developed by the project consortium.



A2 Definition and design of the training Back Pack - An educational framework was decided by the partners to define the methodology of the training, the content and topics to be developed, the ways of validation of knowledge.



A3 GCE Handbook development- The actual development of the training materials is almost finalised and under review. The topics are:

- Inequality and poverty
- Cultural diversity
- Human rights
- Media literacy and internet safety
- Sustainability and consumption
- Community actions



GCE Learning Motivation Environment (LME) - The educational Platform to host the training materials and to assure the qualification of the acquired knowledge is under construction.
