Some leaflets were printed for the participants to get informed during the event.



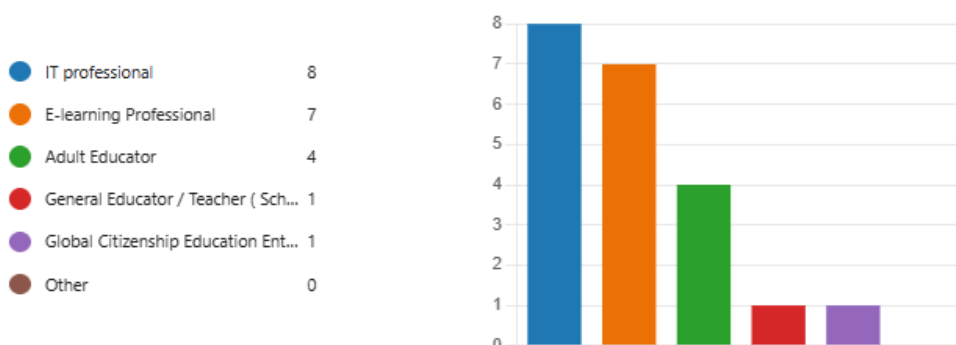
Event Evaluation

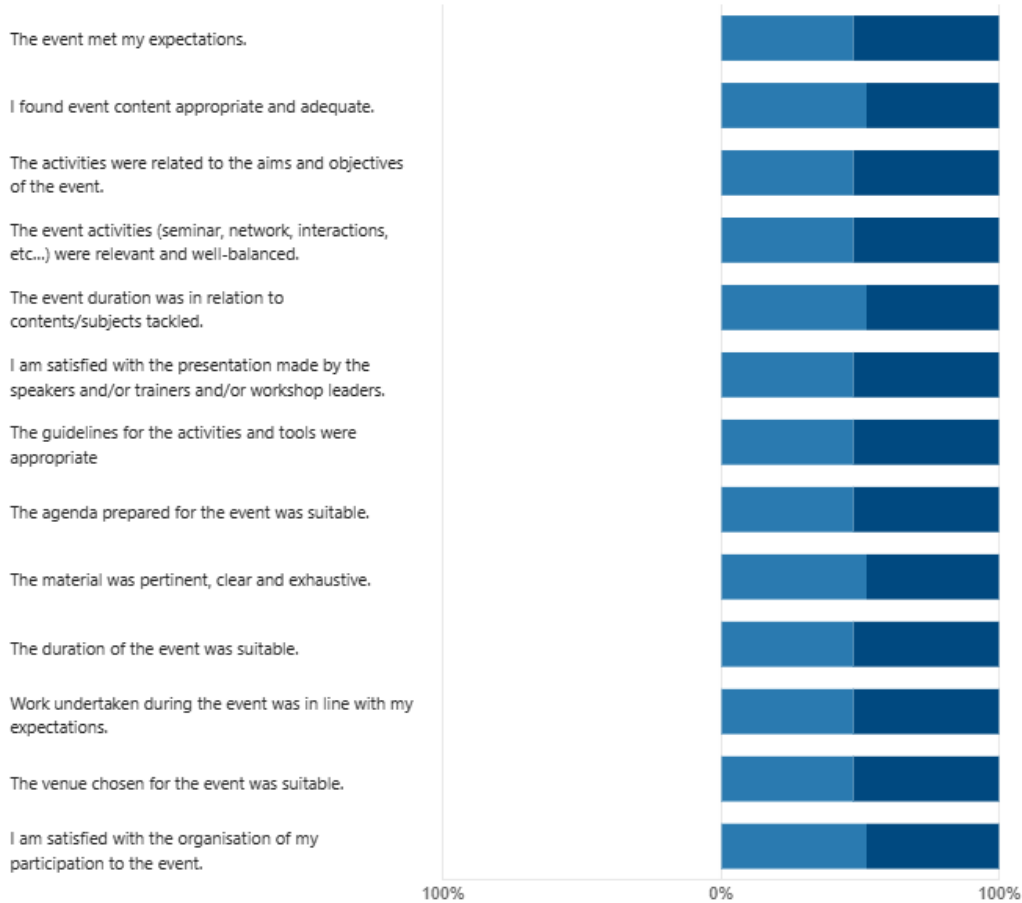


Question 4: Rate the Statements
