1. INTRODUCTION

2. REPORT OF THE EVENTS

As already mentioned, the Multiplier Event of Cyprus was divided in two sessions and in total 51 people participated.

It was decided to first visit a village since the project is about the education and training of people living in rural areas and Polistipos is a village with a community that works now on becoming more active.

Then, Emphasys Centre decided to organize an event at the Mall of Cyprus, the biggest mall of Nicosia, during which, it could easily attract people of different profiles and inform them about the project.

The profile of people varied, emphasizing mainly on adults living in rural areas, and all of them showed their interest in the topics presented in this project since there are different and enough to accommodate the need and desire of each one.

After being informed about the project, its results and the main digital tool, the LME platform, participants answered the questionnaire provided to them and had the opportunity to share their opinion in regards to the project's structure, topics and aims.

Through oral comments and written evaluation, the following conclusions were received:

- Great and important addition to having the content online (through the LME platform). People asked when the platform will be provided in the partner languages.
- The content was clear and there was a good variety of topics. A good addition made has been gender equality, especially in the labour market.
- It may have been better to organize the event at a more quiet place (1 answer received for the event at the Mall of Cyprus)
- Some participants would like to have more time for discussion, especially on the topic of CGE.
- Some participants would like to have more time for practical activities (answer all the quizzes for Open Badges)
